Extracting Data

Running the self-extracting file copies the data and report files to a customer specified folder.

To install the AnySite data update onto a local machine:

1. Insert the MapInfo AnySite PMB Data Update CD.
(If the installation does not automatically start, navigate to the CD drive in Windows Explorer and double-click **AnySite_CA - PMB.exe**)
A self-extractor window appears.
2. Click the **Browse** button.
The Browse for Folder window appears.
3. Locate the directory where you have AnySite Canada installed (for example, C:\Program Files\MapInfo).
4. Click **OK** to return the self-extractor window, then click **Unzip**.
2 files Unzipped Successfully window appears.
5. Click **OK**.
6. Click **Close**.

Installing the License

You must install the license file prior accessing your updated PMB data.

1. Place the License CD in the DVD drive.
If the installation does not automatically start, click **Run** from the Microsoft Start menu, browse to the DVD drive, and select **INSTALL.EXE**.
2. In the License Installer screen click **Install** to copy the license file to your AnySite ASDE folder (ensure the path is correct for your installation C:\Program Files\MapInfo\AnySite_CA\Data\ASDE is the default location).
3. A notice dialog appears. Click **OK** when prompted that the installation is complete.

Once you have installed the license file, you must point to it using AnySite Configurator:

1. **Open** the AnySite Configurator.
2. From the **Tools** menu, select **ASDE Settings**.
3. In the License Path text area, click the **Browse** button and point to the new license file (for example, C:\Program Files\MapInfo\AnySite_CA\Data\ASDE\[NAME].lic).
4. Click **OK**.
